- Staff works in several countries in Latin America

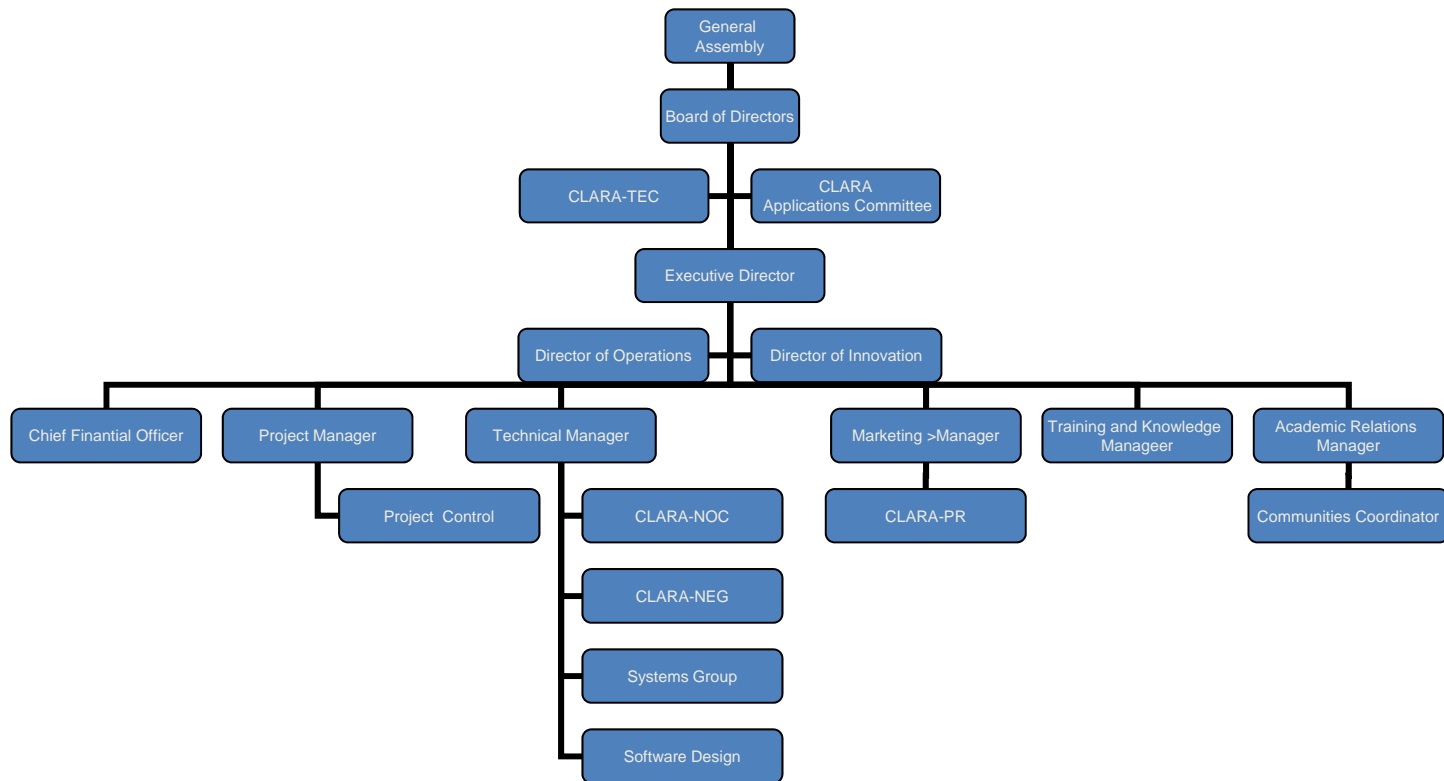

Staff development Strategy

- The number of people directly contracted by CLARA must remain low (below 15)
- Whenever possible, NRENs will perform assigned tasks on behalf of CLARA instead of creating a group of hired personnel: NEG, NOC, SEG, etc.
- Personnel must be located in several countries in the Region
 - Telework is central to this strategy
 - Whenever possible, the local NREN provides offices for the staff of CLARA
 - The local NREN provides Videoconference facilities for CLARA Staff

- Director of Operations
 - Responsible for daily operations, including technical issues as well as financial and administrative issues.

- Technical Manager
 - Software Projects Engineer
- Network Engineering Group (NEG)
 - Assigned to Brazil's NREN
- Network Operations Center (NOC)
 - Assigned to Chile's NREN
- Systems Engineering Group
 - In the process of assignment

Funding

- ALICE2 Funding is providing € 12 Million from December 2008 until August 2012
- Partners contribute € 1.7 Million a year in cash payments. Expected to become € 2.2 Million by 2012.
- Contributions by Brazil (fiber optic and equipment) of US\$ 10 Million from 2009-2012
- Application Projects are funded on a project by project basis applying to the appropriate funding source:
 - FP7, OAS, IDB, etc.
